Willits Unified asked for an update on the projection of our cash flow. The county is creating a current report. We may not need to use the TRAN loan.

Academics:

The Elementary onsite classes are really delightful. The teachers have the time filled with captivating activities and the students are cooperative.

Graduation flyers went out.* The events will be outside this year.
