The May Revise of the state budget was released and there is more money than expected.

Weekly Checkin Report Cards for the end of year were mailed out. There was an overall improvement (40%?) since the mid year report card was sent out.

Teachers: Three teachers declined on the intent to return form. Interviews to fill the empty positions have been ongoing and will wrap up next week. Attended a Virtual Job Fair for California. We made a new video for it about the positives of La Vida.*

27% of the staff filled out the School Climate Survey.

Teacher input on the LCAP suggested that school supply kits appropriate for each grade level be created and provided. Many people live at a distance and shopping can be challenging. Next will be parent input next week.

Students and Parents: Games Day for Elementary students with Book Fair was a true celebration. Many parents helped run the games and brought popcorn and watermelon.

Community Thursday Bar B Que for High School was lightly attended about 30%. Nonetheless it was an enjoyable event. Students put together 32 school supply/ art kits to be sent to the Haiti Orphanage. There were also musical instruments and clothing donations. One senior presented her Economics Project.

Special Ed: Two IEP's were held in May and 1 more is coming up, a Triennial and that is the last one for the year. The Director attended the Selpa Steering Committee which had a section on Charter Schools.
