DIRECTOR'S REPORT: May be expanded at the meeting.

Enrollment: 73, Usually this time of year through January, there are a number of new enrollments.

Financials: Review of Board Account.

1st Interim Budget and the review of the Audit are the main actions of the meeting. **Audit:** The 2021-22 Audit is finally complete. The next steps include negotiations and repayment plan with the State. Because this audit is almost a year past the filing deadline, the auditor requested an extension for the 2022-23 audit. At the request of Superintendent Beebe, a meeting was set up for a discussion of the parameters and timelines of this audit.

Willits Unified: Superintendent Mark Beebe and County Superintendent Nicole Glaser are keeping a close eye on the audit process and outcomes. Weekly meetings are occurring with Mr Beebe.

IRS- The annual 990 taxes had an extension filed in November. However, they are now complete and filed with the Feds and the State.

Academics: The Fall Map session was prolonged for elementary grades and is complete.

Teachers: Misty Ford, the HomeRoom / Lead Teacher for the high school was recruited by Laytonville for their Independent Study Program and her last day was Friday. Her Students are being absorbed by Jason Hodges and Michelle Halsey. This leaves just two teachers in High School.

Also Dave Smith the Geometry Teacher left at the end of Fall term as well. A farewell gathering with students and faculty was held with refreshments on their last teaching day. Both teachers were much loved and will be missed.

Peer Review of Independent Study files for the 2022-23 year is about wrapped up.

Staff: December is a big reporting time with P-1 Attendance with the State and Fall 1 with the big data upload in CALPADs with the State.

Students: Thankfulness Feast and the Fall Performance was festive and creative with the dragon breads and unicorn cakes. Parents were awesome.

Vision and Hearing screening for the elementary grades happened on Tuesday.

High School Onsite Schedule changed because of the low numbers in attendance. Wednesday and Thursday now meet from 10-1:30 for the winter at least.

Special Ed: One Initial IEP and One 504 were held. The Willits and Ukiah Transition Program Reps came and met with our small team about the procedures and signing up potential students.

Coming up: Next Board Meeting January 10 and the Willits Board Meeting is January 11th with the review of the End of Year Reports for the Charter Schools. Community Thursday is Dec 14 and Staff Inservice and party is December 20.
