Enrollment: Lottery is May 1st for the 2024-25 year.

Financials: P-2 Attendance came in at 68.56 ADA, Less than the goal of 70 ADA, but three more than the 2nd Interim Budget was based on.

REAP: Rural Schools grant was submitted.* Estimated at \$22,403.

Insurance: The application cycle for next year submitted.

Willits Unified P-2 Attendance Reports were submitted to Willits and MCOE. Check-ins with Superintendent are to resume this week.

Academics Smarter Balanced test is wrapping up this week 34% participated. There are possibly two 11th graders who have not participated in either test and may loose their spot next year for non-compliance.
