

Special for the 2024-25 year is a community partnership with Leyna Lightman a museum educator and community builder who has received two recognitions by the City of Los Angeles as an Impact Maker to Watch, who recently moved to Ridgewood Ranch. https://www.leynalightman.com/ With the help of some Arts Grant Funding, three artists will provide two-day intensives for La Vida Students. The Willits Arts Center will also host public events.
