DIRECTOR’S REPORT:

Enrollment: Enrollment is at 64. One student was disenrolled for Non-Compliance of the Independent Study Contract; Notice was sent to the home district. (Two this year) A family of three disenrolled. Two new are in process of enrolling.

Financials- This meeting has a focused discussion on the 2nd Interim Budget and Multi Year Budgets as well as the Financials for this year’s LCAP midyear report.

Willits Unified- Business Manager and Director met with the Superintendent and Business Manager for Willits Unifies regarding the MOU to include the 602 funds. The next meeting will be March 4.

La Vida’s End of Year Report was on the agenda for Willits’ Unifields Board Meeting on February 12. The report was approved.

The Williams Review and Fire Marshall Inspection.- both had fixits, with electrical being shared, primarily extension cords. Maintenance Staff has been working on completing the tasks.

Academics- Certificates are going out to Weekly check in Achievers this week and the 100% group receives a La Vida flashlight.

Winter Trimester ends next week March 6. There are some changes to the onsite schedule.

MAP Testing is the month of March.

Special Ed: Three IEPs and one 504 were held. Special Education Coordinator Erika Romandia provided notice to exit employment. Dory Haselswerdt, Registrar and Student Services Liaison who was originally hired with this position in mind has taken on the position.

Students- An emotional storm blew through, one day and extreme undesirable behaviors were seen in two classes. To help return the classes to a harmonious balance and respectfulness to each other, a counseling psychologist who has expertise in working with groups will spend two sessions with two classes to help restore balance and help the students feel safe.

Read A Thon happened all of February with some fun spirit days. The Mendocino Library Van came to provide students with the opportunity to check out books on the honor system.

Friendship has been an emphasis for February.

Teachers- Primary Grades Teacher Brooke Glavich provided a letter of resignation and her last day is Feb 28th. We are interviewing and hope that the transition will be smooth. Brooke is changing career paths.

Independent Study files were due at the end of paperwork week and about 55% are turned in. Board member, Tim Cooper, met with some teachers to help ensure successful outcomes.

edMajic- We are working with edMajic on the Charter Renewal preparations and have the second meeting on February 26.

Site: As mentioned above, the current focus is on making the corrections for the Williams Report and the Fire Marshall Inspection. The oven controls are inconsistent again, which makes it challenging for all the cooking and baking that happens weekly.
